



CODE OF CONDUCT

The Village Pointe® Shopping Center, including its designated roadways and parking lot, is private property. The following Code of Conduct is set forth for the purpose of protecting The Village Pointe Shopping Center legitimate business interests, and any violation of the Code interferes with the commercial nature and function of The Village Pointe Shopping Center. Your entry constitutes your consent to abide by all of the posted rules governing conduct, traffic, and parking. As a visitor at The Village Pointe Shopping Center, you are prohibited from engaging in any of the following activities while at The Village Pointe Shopping Center:

1. Using physical force, obscene language, obscene gestures, or racial, religious or ethnic slurs, which are likely to create a disturbance or impinge on the hearing or speech of other patrons of The Village Pointe Shopping Center.
2. Physically or verbally threatening any person fighting, annoying other through noisy or boisterous activities or by following another person through The Village Pointe Shopping Center or by using sexually explicit language or conduct, or in any other way creating a disturbance which interferes, disrupts or endangers The Village Pointe Shopping Center patrons or its commercial function.
3. Running, skating, skateboarding, bicycling, obstructing or interfering with the free flow of pedestrian traffic or with other patrons' view of windows and other tenant displays or assembling for the purpose of disturbing the peace or committing any unlawful act.
4. Creating litter, or throwing, discarding, or depositing any paper, glass or other matter of any kind on The Village Pointe Shopping Center property, except in designated trash receptacles.
5. Defacing, damaging or destroying any real or personal property constituting part of or located at The Village Pointe Shopping Center and belonging to The Village Pointe Shopping Center, its patrons, or its tenants, including writing, spraying, scratching, or otherwise affixing graffiti on such property.
6. Yelling, screaming, singing, playing of musical instruments, radios or tape players, or otherwise of sufficient volume to impinge on the hearing or peace of other patrons of The Village Pointe Shopping Center.
7. Engaging in non-commercial expressive activity without the proper prior written permission of management of The Village Pointe Shopping Center.
8. Soliciting money or other contributions or , or distributing commercial advertising or promotional material of any kind, or offering samples of items which are sold, available for sale, or available for exchange for a donation or contribution.
9. Failing to be fully clothed or wearing apparel which is likely to provoke a disturbance or embroil other groups or general public in open conflict.
10. Sitting on floors, planters, handrails, stairs, fireplaces or trash receptacles.
11. Possessing any open can, bottle or other receptacle containing any alcoholic beverage, except in areas specifically designated for alcohol consumption by those of legal drinking age.
12. Loitering, delaying, lingering, or remaining idle at The Village Pointe Shopping Center without any useful business for being present.
13. Photographing or videotaping the interior or exterior of The Village Pointe Shopping Center for commercial purposes without permission from management.
14. Engaging in any unlawful activity or behavior.
15. Possession or carrying of any firearms, simulated firearms, or weapons of any kind, openly or concealed, with or without a permit.
16. Damaging, destroying, removing anything or inserting any foreign object or substance into any fountain or fireplace at The Village Pointe Shopping Center.
17. Participating in group tours through shopping center businesses for organized recreational games (i.e., "Scavenger Hunt" and similar activities) where individuals' actions become disruptive to the quiet enjoyment of other customers and store staff.

Parental Escort Policy

Anyone under the age of 17 must be chaperoned and in the presence of an adult (25 or older) after 9:00 p.m. A valid state or school-issued identification card may be required to verify age.

If you fail or refuse to follow this Code of Conduct, you will be asked to leave The Village Pointe Shopping Center. If you fail or refuse to leave The Village Pointe Shopping Center when requested to do so, you may be arrested and prosecuted for Criminal trespass. You may be permanently or temporarily banned from The Village Pointe Shopping Center for your failure to comply with this Code of Conduct.
